**Eligibility:**

All MSA dues-paid members with 4 work-to-show hours.

**Entries:**

3 per artist, 2 or 3 dimensional. **NOTE 2008 CHANGE: a maximum of 3 pieces may be accepted.**

**Requirements:**

1. Entries must be hand-delivered. Submit only the most original form of your art. Work must not have been previously shown at MSA.
2. All framed work must be properly framed, clean and ready for installation, with wire and flat hangers. No clip-on frames or protruding eye screws. Plexiglas rather than glass must be used on works over 30" x 36".
3. No wet paintings. Oil and acrylic works on canvas (or other surfaces which are not glazed) must be framed or stapled on the back with all visible edges painted.
4. All work must be clearly marked with the artist's name, title of work, medium, value, and any special handling instructions.
5. If sold, Gallery receives 30% of selling price. Work for rent must be priced over \$75.
6. It is the responsibility of the artist to help move and install oversized or heavy works.
7. No item may be removed before the close of the show.
8. All photographic prints must be identified by process, i.e. silver gelatin print, Polaroid transfer print, digital print, etc.

**Fees:**

\$5 per piece valued up to \$500. \$1 each additional \$100 of value. Maximum fee is \$10 per piece.

**Marin Society of Artists accepts no responsibility for loss or damage of work.**

**Pick up:**

Non-accepted work to be picked up on notice. Other work should be picked up on Sunday, March 1, between 2:00 and 4:00 PM. Work not picked up within 15 days will be donated to the MSA annual auction.
