



The 99th Annual Members Fine Art Exhibition

September 30-October 24, 2026

Reception Friday, October 16, 5pm-8pm

Theme: This year MSA artists can celebrate 99 years of artistic inspiration and innovation. An achievement we can all be proud of – even though none of us were there in 1927 for the first annual show.

Eligibility: Open to all MSA members who are current with their volunteer commitment. All varieties of artwork are invited, including painting, photography, digital art, sculpture, printing, fabric art, ceramic, all types of craft.

Entries: One to three entries per artist will be accepted.

Requirements:

1. Please complete the MSA Show Entry form available on the MSA website, before bringing in your artwork.
2. Artwork must follow the Specifications for Exhibited Artwork as shown on the MSA website.
3. No artwork is to be removed by the artist before the show closes; and the purchaser should not remove the piece until the end of the show.
4. Artist receives 70% of the sale price from sold works.
5. Reproductions of completed artwork, including Giclee prints, are not accepted. (Does not apply to photographic or digital artwork). No AI work will be accepted.
6. The submitted artist must be identified on the back of each piece in a secure manner with the artist's name, contact information, and title of the artwork.
7. Artwork completed in the last 5 years and not previously shown in MSA shows is preferred.

Fees: \$25 for one piece, \$35 for two, and \$40 for three. Check or cash only (bring exact change).

Prizes: First, Second and Third prize winners will receive 1 free entry to a future show. Honorable mention awards may also be given.

Receiving: Sunday, September 27, 12-3pm and Monday, September 28, 10-1pm.

Pick up: After the show, artwork must be picked up Sunday, October 25, 12-4pm, or Monday, October 26, 10-1pm. Please contact the show chairs if you need to make other arrangements. Note: we do not have storage space for artwork, MSA will not be responsible for work not picked up.
