Items needed in the Wildlife Hospital. Collection bins are located inside of the Marin Society of Artists gallery - open Wednesdays through Sundays, noon to 4 p.m.

- -Towels
- -Pillow cases
- -FLAT (not fitted) sheets, no holes or rips
- -Older heating pads that do **not** have an auto shut-off (used to keep the baby birds warm and if they shut off it is deadly for them)
- -Costco/Kirkland Brand Wild Birdseed 40lb bag
- -Costco/Kirkland Brand paper towels and 2 ply toilet paper (cannot be scented, and ideally, for the toilet paper, not "super-soft" versions like Charmin)
- -Bleach (large bottles)
- -Dishwashing gloves all sizes
- -AA batteries
- -Unscented liquid laundry detergent
- -Dawn dish soap
- -Raw, not-in-shell, unsalted pecans, almonds, walnuts
- -Masking tape
- -Trader Joe's brand creamy, **non-salted**, **unsweetened** peanut butter. The consistency of the TJ's peanut butter is perfect for their "songbird crumble"
- -lams brand kitten kibble (available at Petco or Safeway). Only lams and only kitten kibble, please
- -"Chicken and gravy" baby food. Only this flavor, any brand
- -Gift certificates to Trader Joe's, Safeway, Smart 'n Final

Please no canned cat or dog food, no opened bags of cat/dog kibble, and no specialty foods such as "kidney diet," "senior diet," etc.
