Reception: Friday, March 13, 5-8pm (2nd Friday ArtWalk)

Theme: Figuratively Speaking — (i.e. Portraits, People, the Figure) From portraiture to expressive figurative work, to photographing people and places, there are many ways artists respond to the human presence—art that reflects how we see one another, how we tell our stories, and our lives shape our artistic expression. All styles of art and mediums are welcome (except film and video).

Receiving: Sunday, March 1, 2026, noon-3pm, Monday, March 2, 2026, 10am-1pm.

Eligibility: Open to all current MSA members. Members are invited to submit up to three (3) of their original works. Members with a “volunteer” membership should be committed to volunteering on a regular basis.

Fees: \$25 for one piece, \$35 for two pieces and \$40 for three pieces. Check or cash only (exact change please)

Requirements: Artwork must follow the Specifications for Exhibited Artwork shown on MSA website.

1. Complete the entry form available on the MSA website, bring it with your artwork on receiving dates. Enter 1 to 3 works, 2 or 3-dimensional.
2. Artwork must be identified on the back in a secure manner with the artist's name, contact information and title of the work.
3. No item should be removed by the artist before the show closes.
4. MSA gallery receives 30% of the sale price from sold works.
5. Reproductions of completed artwork, including Giclee prints, are not accepted. (This does not apply to photographic or digital artwork)

Awards: First Place, Second Place, Third Place and Honorable Mention awards will be given.

Jurors: MSA EAC show chair(s) + juror volunteer(s) will jury this member show.

Pick up: After the show, artists must pick up their work on Sunday, March 29th, 12-3 pm or Monday, March 30th, 10am-1pm. Please contact the show chairs if other arrangements need to be made at shows@msartists.org

MSA has no storage space for work not picked up and is not responsible for remaining artwork. Work not picked up within 7 days will be considered a donation to MSA. Marin Society of Artists accepts no responsibility for loss or damage of work. Marin Society of Artists reserves the right to photograph any artwork for publicity purposes.
