RECEPTION: Friday, September 11, 5-8pm

Theme: Color! Members are invited to explore and celebrate the power of color. Whether through bold palettes or subtle monochromatic harmonies, this show will display how color speaks a universal language.

Eligibility: Open to Marin Society of Artists members who are current with their volunteer hours.

Entries: One to three entries per artist, 2D or 3D dimensional, will be accepted. No film or video.

Juror: Prize winners will be chosen by a panel of MSA members.

Requirements:

1. Please complete the MSA Show Entry form, available on the MSA website, before bringing in your artwork.
2. Artwork must follow the Specifications for Exhibited Artwork as shown on the MSA website.
3. No artwork is to be removed by the artist before the show closes; and the purchaser should not remove the piece until the end of the show.
4. MSA gallery receives 30% of the sale price from sold works.
5. Reproductions of completed artwork, including Giclee prints, are not accepted. (Does not apply to photographic or digital artwork). No AI work will be accepted.
6. The submitted artist must be identified on the back of each piece in a secure manner with the artist's name, contact information, and title of the artwork.
7. Artwork completed in the last 5 years and not previously shown in MSA shows is preferred.

Fees: Members & guests: \$25 for one piece, \$35 for two, and \$40 for three. **Check or cash only. If you pay with cash, please bring the exact amount, change will not be available.**

Prizes: 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners will receive 1 free entry to future shows. Several Honorable Mention awards may also be given.

Receiving: Sunday, August 30, 12-3pm and Monday, August 31, 10-1pm.

Pick up: Artwork must be picked up on Sunday, September 27, 12-3pm or Monday, September 28, 10am -1pm. Please contact the show chairs if other arrangements need to be made. Note: We do not have storage space for artwork. MSA will not be responsible for work not picked up.

Partnership: MSA will partner with our neighbor, Vivalon, which serves older adults and people with disabilities. For more than 50 years Meals on Wheels has delivered meals to the homebound. The organization found that their clients often shared meals with their pets, so a pet food program was initiated. MSA members and guests are invited to donate canned (no kibble) pet food and/or pet items like collars, leashes and toys. Collection barrels will be in the gallery.
