• Items needed in the Wildlife Hospital •

**Collection bins are located inside of the Marin Society of Artists gallery
1515 3rd St (at E St), San Rafael, CA Wednesdays - Sundays, noon to 4 p.m.**

- Clean flat sheets, pillowcases and towels. No items with holes
(Used and clean items okay but avoided scented products)
- Older style heating pads with NO auto shut off -- to keep baby birds warm
- Birdseed with very little filler in it (i.e. the expensive bird seed)
- Costco Kirkland paper towels and 2-ply toilet paper. *(Nothing soft nor scented)*
- Bleach, gloves, unscented liquid laundry detergent
- Dawn dish soap
- Masking tape
- Raw, (not in shell) Almonds and Pecans, plain and unsalted
- Trader Joe's brand creamy unsalted peanut butter. This brand/type only!
- Iams brand kitten food kibble. Only this brand and only kitten kibble
- Chicken and gravy baby food—any brand but only chicken and gravy
- Canned cat food (NO special diet like kidney or weight loss)
- Canned sardines in water (not oil)
- NO canned cat/dog food or other kibble except as noted above

Please no canned cat or dog food, no opened bags of cat/dog kibble, and no specialty foods such as "kidney diet," "senior diet," etc.
