Theme: **Summertime: Sun, exotic locations, bright colors, fun ... what does "Summertime" mean to you?**

Prize Juror: Michael Friedland. Michael studied painting and design at Paier College of Art, Coronado School of Fine Arts and Philadelphia College of Art. Retired now from a forty-year career as a designer, he has been teaching painting (with watercolor) for nine years. He teaches locally in San Rafael, Corte Madera and Belvedere/Tiburon. He teaches for two weeks each year at Yosemite in their Artists in Residency Program. He will teach a ten-day workshop this summer at La Romita School of Art in Umbria, Italy. Michael is on the California Watercolor Association's board and is Director of their National Exhibition. He is an elected member of the Baywood Artists.

Prizes: First Prize, 3 free entries in future shows. Second Prize, 2 Free entries. Third Prize, 1 free entry. Several Honorable Mention awards will be given.

Eligibility: Open to MSA members. Those with volunteer membership must be current with their volunteer commitment.

Requirements:

1. Artwork must follow the Specifications for Exhibited Artwork as shown on the MSA website.
2. No artwork is to be removed by the artist before the show close of the sale.
3. MSA receives 30% of the sale from sold works.
4. Reproductions of completed artwork, including Giclee prints, are not accepted. (Does not apply to photo or digital artwork).
5. Entries: Enter one to three works, 2 or 3 dimensional. Complete the MSA Show Entry form (available on the MSA website) and bring it in with your artwork on the receiving dates.

Fees: \$20 for one piece, \$30 for two, \$35 for three. Check or cash only. If paying with cash, please bring the exact amount Change will not be available.

Receiving: Sunday, June 11, 12pm to 3pm, and Monday, June 12, 10am to 1pm.

Reception: Friday, June 16, 5pm to 8pm.

Pick Up: After the show, artwork must be picked up on Sunday, July 9, 12pm to 3pm, or Monday, July 10, 10am to 1pm Please contact the show chairs if other arrangements need to be made at shows@msartists.org
