

ARTIST'S FAVORITE 2026

January 7 to January 31, 2026 RECEPTION: Friday, January 9, 5pm to 8pm.

Theme:

The artist should select up to THREE of their favorite works of art for this show. Art previously shown at MSA are invited. Art that previously won prizes at MSA shows are especially invited! Any media is allowed, 2-dimensional or 3-dimensional. (No video or film).

Eligibility:

Open to Marin Society of Artists members. who are current with their volunteer hours. Members with a "Volunteer" membership should be current with their volunteer hours. (At least 2 hours per month).

Entries:

One to three entries per artist, 2D or 3D dimensional, will be accepted.

Requirements:

- 1. Please complete the MSA Show Entry form, available on the MSA website, before bringing in Your artwork on the receiving dates shown below.
- 2. Artwork must follow the Specifications for Exhibited Artwork as shown on the MSA website.
- 3. No artwork is to be removed by the artist before the show closes; and the purchaser should not remove the piece until the end of the show.
- 4. MSA gallery receives 30% of the sale price from sold works.
- 5. Reproductions of completed artwork, including Giclee prints, are not accepted. (Does not apply to photographic or digital artwork).
- 6. The submitted artist must be identified on the back of each piece in a secure manner with the artist's name, contact information, and title of the artwork.

Fees:

\$20 for one piece, \$30 for two, and \$35 for three. Payment with check preferred. If you pay with cash, please bring the exact amount, change will not be available. No credit cards, please.

Prizes:

Conventional awards will not be given in this show. There will be a "People's Choice" award voted on by visitors and artists at the reception.

Receiving:

Sunday, January 4, 12pm to 3pm, or Monday January 5, 10am to 1pm.

Pick up:

After the show, artwork must be picked up on Sunday, February 1, 12pm to 3pm, or Monday, February 2, 10am to 1pm. Please contact the show chairs if other arrangements need to be made. Note: we do not have storage space for artwork. MSA will not be responsible for work not picked up.
