Eligibility: Open to MSA members. Those with volunteer membership must be current with their volunteer commitment.

Requirements: Artwork must follow the Specifications for Exhibited Artwork as shown on the MSA website.

1. No artwork is to be removed by the artist before the show close of the sale.
2. MSA receives 30% of the sale from sold works.
3. Reproductions of completed artwork, including Giclee prints, are not accepted. (Does not apply to photo or digital artwork).
4. Entries: Enter 1-3 works, 2 or 3 dimensional. Complete the MSA Show Entry form (available on the website) and bring it in with your artwork on the receiving dates.

Entry Fees: \$20 for one piece, \$30 for two, \$35 for three. Check or cash only. If paying with cash, please bring the exact amount. Change will not be available.

Receiving: Sunday, January 5, 12pm to 3pm, and Monday, January 6, 10am to 1pm.

Pick Up: After the show, artwork must be picked up on Sunday, February 2, 12 - 3pm, or Monday, February 3, 10am -1pm. Please contact the show chairs if other arrangements need to be made at shows@msartists.org
