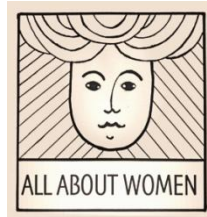




# MARIN SOCIETY OF ARTISTS

## PRESENTS



**ALL ABOUT WOMEN 2023** is an ONLINE exhibition open to all artists, age 18 and over, regardless of gender. Artists are invited to submit artwork about women and their lives, past, present and future, and the issues that concern them.

Open to painting, photography, sculpture, printmaking, mixed media, fiber art, ceramics and all types of fine art crafts. (No film or video.) The show will be presented in two forms – an **online presentation** in the MSA “Virtual Gallery” which will include the price and contact information of the artist. In addition, a **video version** showing all works in the show will be available and will remain available to view after the show closes.

Only online entries with digitally uploaded images to CaFÉ will be accepted. Digital entries must be RECEIVED via the CaFÉ application by July 17, 2023 before 11:59pm Mountain Time. Notification of acceptance will be by email and an online list of accepted artwork entries on the MSA website. Note: Artwork previously juried into an MSA exhibition will not be accepted.

**EXHIBITION DATES:** August 1, 2023 through September 30, 2023. The YouTube version of the exhibition will remain available after September 30.

**RECEPTION:** A virtual ZOOM reception will be held on **Sunday, August 13** at 5pm Pacific Time. Details and the link to the ZOOM will be released well in advance.

**DEADLINE TO ENTER:** July 17, 2023

**JUROR: LORI AUSTIN.** Lori Austin is a gallerist and entrepreneur with over 30 years of experience operating retail galleries in northern and southern California. She was VP of Sales & Marketing for Spirits in Stone from 1991 until 2010 and then Managing Director of Terra Firma Gallery from 2010 until the Fall of 2018. Lori founded Lori Austin Gallery in October 2018. Lori is passionate about curating and promoting contemporary art in all mediums.

### **AWARDS:**

First Prize: \$500. Second Prize: \$300. Third Prize: \$100. Several non-monetary Honorable Mention awards may be given at the Juror's discretion.

All properly prepared entries (refer to digital file image requirements) will be viewed and judged by the juror. The decision of the juror is final. No more than 2 works by an artist will be included in the final juried selection.

**ENTRY PROCEDURE AND DIGITAL IMAGE FORMAT:**

Entry instructions may be found on our website: <https://www.marinsocietyofartists.org> or on CaFÉ. If you are already registered with CaFÉ, you may use your existing username and password to enter this show. All entries must be submitted with digital images and must adhere to CaFÉ requirements.

Your entries must first be uploaded to "My Portfolio" on the CaFÉ application. You then choose images from your "Portfolio" to be entered in this exhibition.

- **Image Format:** JPG or JPEG

- **Dimensions:** 1200 pixels or greater on the longest side. CaFÉ may readjust your dimensions after entry to fit the limitations. Size: under 5 MB

- **Description:** the description entered in your portfolio with your image will be visible in the Online Exhibition, but not in the You Tube version.

- **Please check your entries** for accuracy and typos. No changes to title, price, or other material information will be permitted after July 17, 2023.

- **For technical help**, click on **CaFÉ HELP**.

**CALENDAR SCHEDULE:**

- Digital Entries Deadline: Thursday, July 17, 2023, before 11:59p.m. Mountain Time.

- Notification of Accepted Entries: July 25, 2023 (by midnight Pacific Time).

- Show Opens: August 1, 2023 (online gallery)

- Reception (ZOOM call): Sunday, August 13, 2023, at 5pm PT.

- Show Closes in the online gallery September 30, 2023. The YouTube video version will remain available.

**ACCEPTED ARTWORK NOTIFICATION:**

Artists will receive email notices of accepted artwork by July 25, 2023, (by midnight Pacific Time). A SEPARATE email notice will be sent on the same date showing non-accepted artwork. In addition, a list of the accepted artwork will be posted on the MSA website.

Note: we reserve the right to not accept entries that are substantially misrepresented.

**SALES:**

Artwork in the show will be for sale at the price chosen by the artist. If the artist does NOT wish their entry to be for sale, they should show a \$0 price and select "not for sale" for that piece. This price does not include shipping and handling costs. The artist will handle the sale of their artwork and shipping thereof. Any interested purchaser will contact the artist directly regarding purchase of artist's work. 100% of the sale of work will go to the artist; no commission to MSA.

The artist's email contact information will be posted along with their artwork image on the Online Gallery show so that the artist can be contacted by potential buyers. HOWEVER: If the artwork is selected for the exhibition, the artist may opt to show their website link instead of their email contact information with their entry by indicating such on their CaFÉ entry.

A non-refundable entry fee will be charged.

Non-members: \$35 for 3 entries, \$7 for each additional entry up to (10) pieces.

MSA members: \$30 for 3 entries (with coupon code), \$7 for each additional entry up to (10) pieces.

Payments to be made by credit card, debit (VISA or MC) or PayPal through the CaFÉ application. Diptychs and triptychs count as one piece, use only one image of the entire diptych or triptych. Fee payment does not guarantee that any/all artworks submitted for jurying will be included in the exhibition. Note: Artwork previously shown in an MSA exhibition will not be accepted
