MSA Member's Fine Art Exhibition and Holiday Sale
November 30 to December 21, 2023

- Theme: Fine Art of all kinds, to be displayed on the walls. In addition, members can reserve space on a table or pedestals for small items such as cards, small pieces of art, or gift items.
- Prizes: No prizes offered for this exhibition.
- Eligibility: Open to MSA members. Those with volunteer membership must be current with their volunteer commitment.

Requirements:

Artwork must follow the Specifications for Exhibited Artwork as shown on the MSA website.

1. In this show, sold artwork should be taken by the purchaser upon sale. Artists may replace the artwork with another piece of similar size..
2. MSA receives 30% of the sale from sold works.
3. Reproductions of completed artwork, including Giclee prints, are not accepted. (Does not apply to photo or digital artwork). NOTE: items for sale on a table/pedestal in this show may be Giclee prints or other reproductions, but should be labeled as such).

Entries: Enter one to three works, 2 or 3 dimensional. Complete the MSA Show Entry form (available on the MSA website) and bring it in with your artwork on the receiving dates. Table Entries – no limit on the number of pieces for sale on the portion of a table reserved by the artist.

Fees:

ART FOR WALLS: \$20 for one piece, \$30 for two, \$35 for three. Check or cash only. If paying with cash, please bring the exact amount. Change will not be available.

ART FOR TABLES/PEDESTALS: 5 spaces are available for small items:

Three tables are available. \$35 per table (24" x 48"). These will be placed by the low blue wall beside the staircase.

A pedestal area formed by four pedestals in a row – by the "pegboard wall" near the kitchenette – is available for \$50. Dimensions: 8" x 18". NOTE: Items on the table should be no more than 12" in height. Does not include use of the pegboard wall.

NOTE: Artists need to label works for sale with the artist's name, the title or description of piece and the price so the gallerist can fill out the purchase form.

RESERVE IN ADVANCE

Tables or the pedestals must be reserved by close of receiving (Monday, November 27 at 1pm). Send a message to shows@msartists.org

Receiving: Sunday, November 26, 12pm to 3pm, and Monday, November 27, 10am to 1pm.
Tables/Pedestals should be set up between November 26 and November 29.

Reception: Friday, December 8, 5pm to 8pm. Coincides with Second Friday Art Walk. Pick Up:
After the show, artwork must be picked up on Friday, December 22, 12pm to 3pm, or Saturday, December 23, 10am to 1pm. Please contact the show chairs if other arrangements need to be made at shows@msartists.org
